» One of Dubai's most picturesque locations will be hosting a debut exhibition of striking abstract art this autumn.

The Majlis Gallery, set in one of the Bastakiya area's historic wind towered buildings, is an oasis of tranquility in the bustling city. The gallery will be showing the distinctive art of Suzanna Pejaska, her first exhibition in the Gulf.

With strong influences from her native Macedonia, Suzanna's art is made up of monochrome and densely coloured striped blocks, reminiscent of the traditional ornamental costume of her homeland.

Although she moved from her Macedonian fishing village to France at the age of three, her memories of the vibrantly coloured aprons of her relatives are still strong in her mind, emerging throughout her work. With distinctive reds and an extraordinary woven fabric-like texture to her work, Suzanna's exhibition is certain to be a visual treat.
